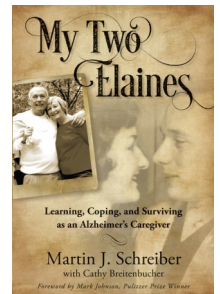

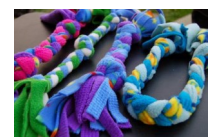

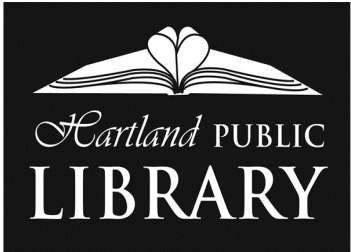
READ TO GLADYS
