Hartland Hires New Village Administrator

Hartland, Wisconsin– October 28, 2019 – Village of Hartland Board of Trustees has hired Timothy Rhode to be the next Village Administrator. Timothy Rhode is expected to start in early January with the Village of Hartland.

Village President Jeffrey Pfannerstill noted, “We are very excited that Timothy Rhode will be the next Village Administrator in Hartland. Through discussions with the Village Board, Village staff and Timothy Rhode himself; we are confident that the Village of Hartland is making the best move by having Timothy Rhode join us. Hartland is moving in a great direction, we are moving forward. I am confident that Timothy Rhode will be in line with my goal to keep moving Hartland forward.”

In speaking about his new position, Rhode said, “I am honored to have been selected to be the next Village Administrator. I would like to thank Village President Pfannerstill and the Village Board for selecting me to the position.”

Mr. Rhode currently serves as the Town Administrator for Cedarburg, a position he has held for the last four years. In addition to managing the Town of Cedarburg, he has 16 years of municipal management experience including the City of St. Francis, Village of Butler and City of Monticello, Iowa.

Mr. Rhode is a graduate of The University of Wisconsin Whitewater where he received a bachelor’s degree in Public Policy and Administration, and also holds a Masters degree from The University of Wisconsin Milwaukee in Public Administration.

Public Administration Associates, Oshkosh, assisted the Village in its search. Over Thirty candidates applied for the position. The Village Board met twice to narrow the field, bringing three candidates to Hartland for a 2-day interview process earlier this month.
