Steps the Village is taking:

- Village officials continue to closely monitor recommendations from the [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention](#) and the [Wisconsin Department of Health Services](#) and will implement those recommendations as appropriate.
- In-person absentee voting and registering for voting will take place at Village Hall in the Village Board Room Monday-Friday from 7:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.
- **Village Hall front counter service will close effective Thursday, March 19th. Business with the Village will continue by phone, email or appointment only.**
- The Village is increasing the frequency of cleaning of common areas, door handles, railings, etc. at all Village buildings to make them as safe as possible.
- All bills due to the Village of Hartland or Hartland Water Utility (next water bill goes out March 30th and will be due April 20th) should be either mailed to the Village, placed in one of our 2 drop boxes or paid online via credit card or bank information (Fees may apply for online payments).
- The Village is following the guidance of the Wisconsin Department of Health Services regarding public gatherings. We will keep the public informed of any cancellations on social media and through the Village website.
- Consider accessing Village services online or by phone. You can pay your utility bill, request permits, sign up for recreation classes/activities, fill out license applications, etc. on our website <https://www.villageofhartland.com/> Village staff is also accessible by phone at 262-367-2714, Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
- The Library is closed until further notice, but have moved their story times online. New Videos will be posted daily to Facebook. Don't forget about their online resources, where you can access millions of free downloads from home.
