RESIDENTIAL COLLECTION REGULATIONS – VILLAGE OF HARTLAND

Garbage:

Weekly, from each single living unit, all **Normal Household Refuse** such as non-recyclable paper and garbage will be collected, provided the materials are in plastic bags no larger than 32-gallons in capacity, and do not exceed 60 pounds in weight.

Recycling:

Recyclables such as glass bottles, plastic containers marked with #1 or #2, and aluminum or tin cans, should be placed together in recycling bin or separate container. **Please do not dispose of recyclable materials in plastic or salt bags.** Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office paper, cereal & snack boxes, beverage carriers, paper egg cartons, paper towel rolls, tissue boxes and paper back books should be **flattened** and contained in paper bags or tied in bundles, and placed on top of commingled recyclables. Corrugated cardboard must be flattened, cut in pieces no larger than 3'X4'X10", and bundled. Bundles of cardboard must be placed on top of commingled recyclables.

Non-Freon Appliances and Furniture:

Large items such as a stove, dishwasher, water softener, water heater, dryer, washing machine, sofa, couch, chair, bed, box spring/mattresses, TV or stereo will also be collected weekly if left at the curb. Please call our office to schedule an appliance pick up. It is not necessary to call for furniture pick ups. Note: Collection of appliances is not necessarily on the same day as your regularly scheduled route day and must be scheduled in advance.

Freon Appliances:

There is a \$25 charge for the collection of appliances containing freon such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers. Residents must call Veolia Environmental Services at (262) 367-6040 to schedule a freon appliance pick up. Payment must be made at the time of collection. Items must be placed at the curb. Note: Collection of appliances is not necessarily on the same day as your regularly scheduled route day and must be scheduled in advance.

Building Materials:

Resident generated building materials such as wood, drywall, plaster, shingles, siding, windows, doors, cabinets, sinks, toilet bowls, (if tank and bowl are separated), and basins must be in containers weighing less than 60 pounds each, or tied in four foot (4') bundles no heavier than 60 pounds each. Large cardboard boxes are not acceptable containers. There is a limit of one – 32 gallon can of building materials collected per week at no charge. A fee will be assessed for additional material and must be paid for at the time of collection. No building materials from contracted jobs will be collected.

Carpet:

Carpet and carpet padding must be cut in four (4) foot lengths, rolled and tied. Rolls can be no larger than one (1) foot in diameter and have a 60 pound weight limit each. One roll will be collected per week at no charge. A fee will be assessed for additional material and must be paid for at the time of collection.

Items Not Included in Service:

Rock, dirt, stone, concrete, landscape timbers, piers, auto parts, batteries, tires, yard waste, brush, and fire logs will not be collected as part of the normal weekly collection service. We would have to estimate a charge before making collections of these types of materials. **We do not accept paint/stains, pool chemicals, lead acid batteries, waste oil, and/or other hazardous waste chemicals.**

Location of Garbage and Recyclables:

The garbage and recyclables must be placed within five (5) feet of Village serviced road in front of each residence. Please have your garbage out for collection by 6:30 a.m. **We will not be responsible for any items left within ten (10) feet of cans.**

Holidays:

Veolia Environmental Services recognizes the following Legal Holidays: New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
