**DIRECTIONS:**

Color in each shape once you've done each Early Literacy activity.

**Set an example.** Let your child see you reading your books to help them develop their own love of reading.

Point out the letters in your child's names that you see in a book or on a sign.

Talk about the things you want to do today and write them down.

**Ask questions about the story and pictures:** What is that? What sound does it make?

**Color scavenger hunt!** Pick a color and look for things in your house that have that color!

**Count objects on the page.** This helps strengthen early math skills.



**SIGN UP FOR "1000 BOOKS BEFORE KINDERGARTEN" FOR YEAR-ROUND LEARNING AND FUN!**

**Sing "If You're Happy and You Know It" together.** Signing helps build vocabulary and phonic awareness.

**Word hunt!** Teach a simple word like "cat." Then try to find it in your book.

**Read a book that rhymes.** Rhyming helps distinguish sounds and create language formation.

While walking, play "I Spy" together.

**START!**

**Clap the syllables of your name and your family members.** This helps kids understand the rhythm of language.

Repetition is key to retaining information.  
**Reread a favorite story.**

**Run you finger along the words as you read to your child.** This creates a connection between your sounds and the words.
